Fallen Soldiers Memorial Torch Run

2020 Memorial Torch Run - July 12 - Aug. 2

As a participating rider, there's no fee to ride. All individual riders, ride chapters and groups are encouraged to participate and ride. Whether you decide to ride one leg, one day, several days, or the entire cross country journey, the amount of time you decide to ride is completely up to you. One thing is for certain, this is a life changing ride for anyone who chooses to participate. If you're a first year rider, it's our promise you'll want to do it again and again each and every year.

Overnight Stops and Meals

Our Tribute to Fallen Soldiers Memorial Torch Motorcycle Ride is proud to partner with proactive community organizations like the American Legion, VFW and Elks Lodge as we make our way across the country. At the end of each travel day our ride procession will spend the night at one of these community organizations. Our 'Overnight Host' will provide a large space within their building for riders to put down their air mattresses, cots and sleeping bags to sleep for the night. In many cases, these organizations will provide cots, however that isn't always a dedicated item. All riders should travel with their own comfortable bedding.

In addition, our 'Overnight Host' will provide complimentary meals. Upon our arrival at the end of each day, a potluck style dinner will be available (complimentary) for all riders. This is typically a hot meal with salad and desserts plus beverages. The following morning, our 'Overnight Host' will also provide a complimentary breakfast before our departure. This typically includes, eggs, bacon, hashed browns, fruit, pastries and coffee.

Each morning there will be a 'Daily Ride Briefing' (DRB) to go over the route, timing and family visits for the day. In case of break downs or unforeseen incidents along the route, it's important that all riders know where our ride procession will end on that particular day so they might have the opportunity to rejoin the ride. These are extremely important and valuable briefings to attend. The (DRB) will begin each morning at 8:00 AM. The ride procession departs each morning at 8:30 AM. Each travel day is approximately 8:30 am to 6:00 pm.
